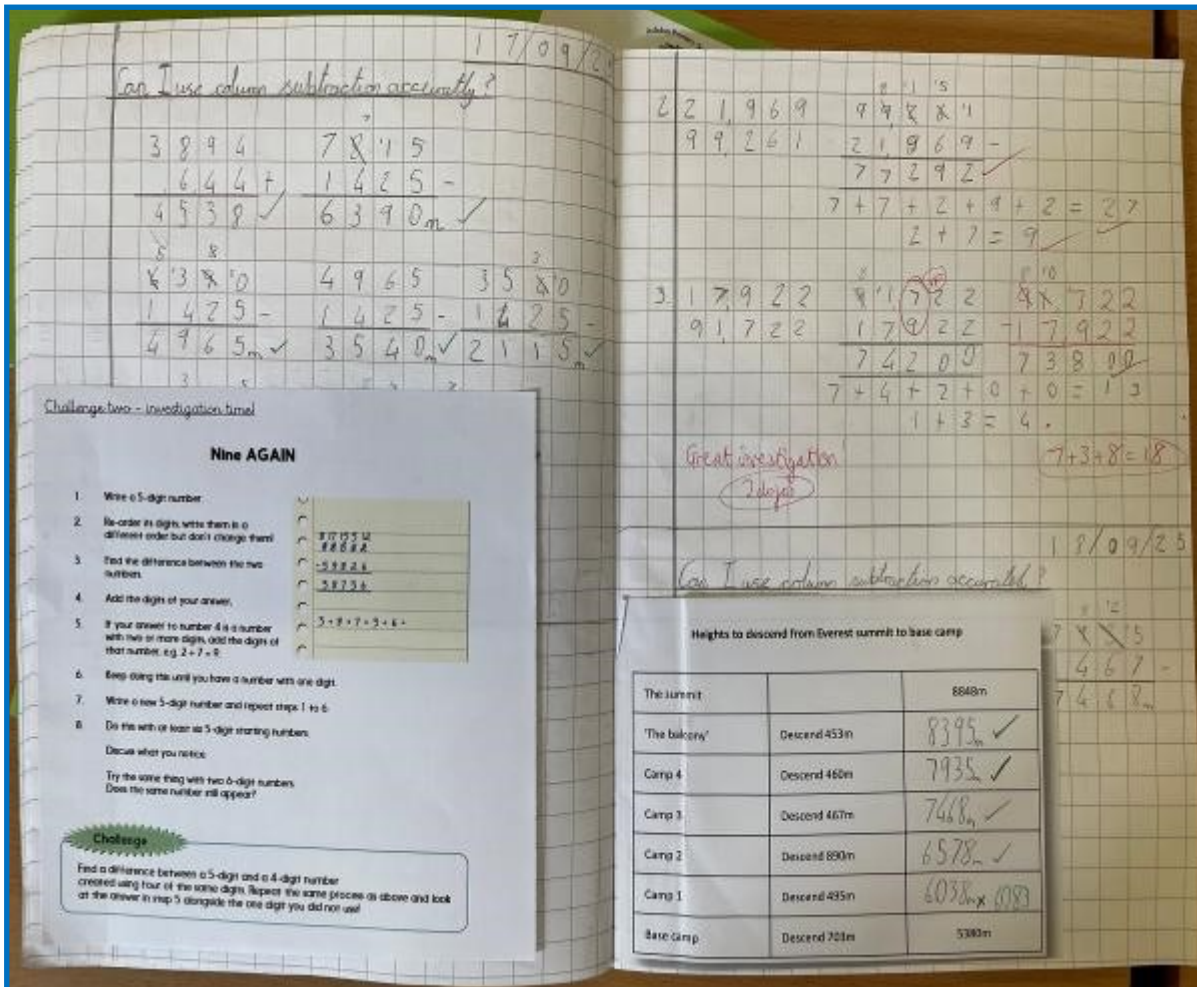
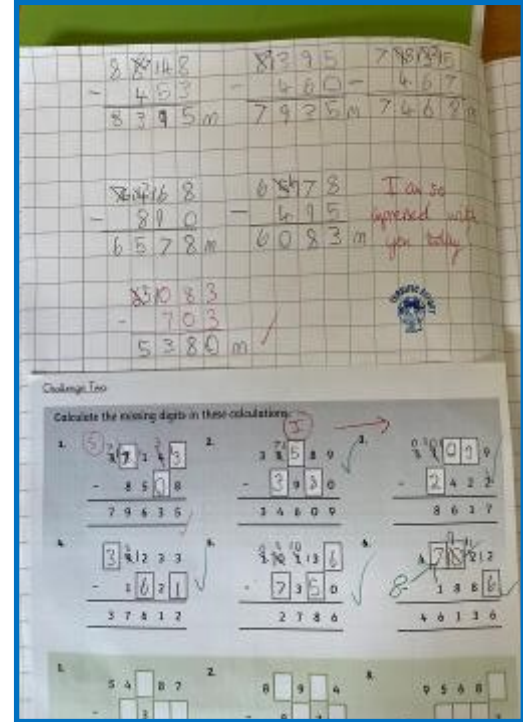
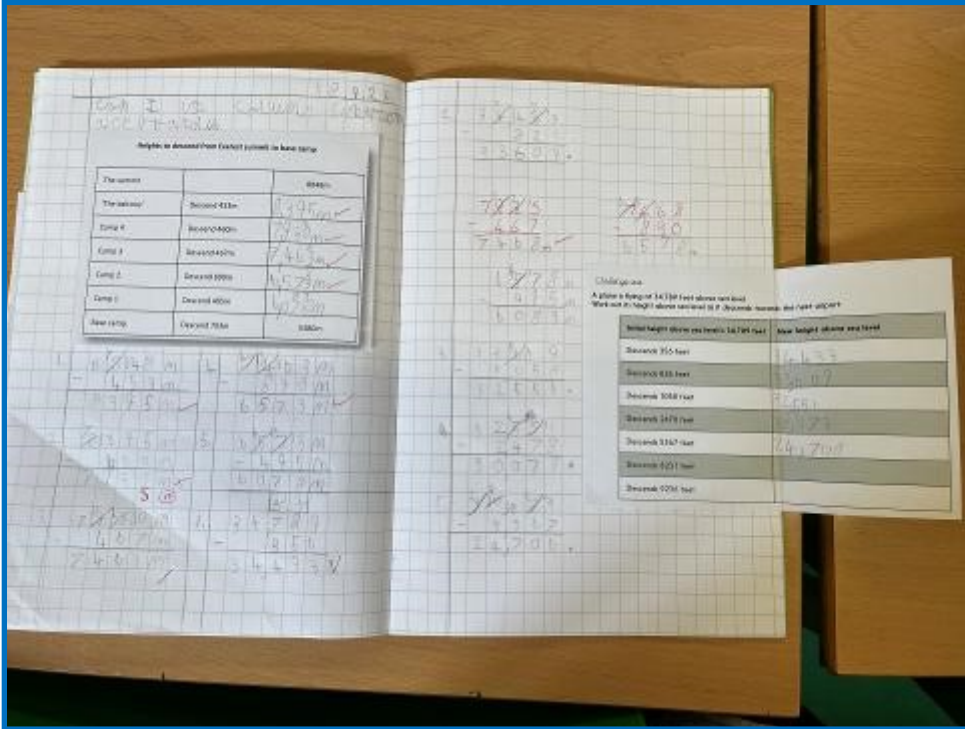


Jupiter Art Time
