Reception and Year 1

A brief example of a typical day. Times are fixed, but what happens inside them varies from day to day — assemblies, PE, trips, visitors and special events all move things around.

Time	What happens
08:00 – 08:50	<i>Breakfast Club</i>
08:50 – 09:00	Gates open — children wait on the playground with staff
09:00	Whistle blows — children go into class
09:00 – 09:15	Registration and morning activities
09:15 – 10:45	Morning session
10:45 – 11:00	Break
11:00 – 12:15	Morning session
12:15 – 13:30	Lunch — first sitting, then out to play
13:25	Tidy the playground
13:30	Teachers collect the children from the playground; afternoon registration
13:30 – 15:15	Afternoon session
15:15 – 15:30	Story and end-of-day reflection
15:30	End of the school day
15:30 – 17:30	<i>After-School Club</i>

The school day is the same for every class at Ashdon. The only difference is when each class eats: Mars sits down at 12:15 and Saturn and Jupiter at 12:30. Everyone plays together afterwards and comes back in at 13:30.

Our school week totals 32.5 hours — 09:00 to 15:30, five days a week. Registers close at 09:10; a child arriving after that is recorded as absent rather than late.
