

Hautbois Residential

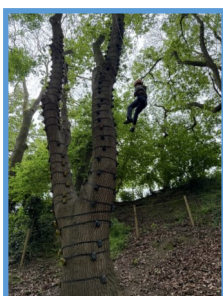
